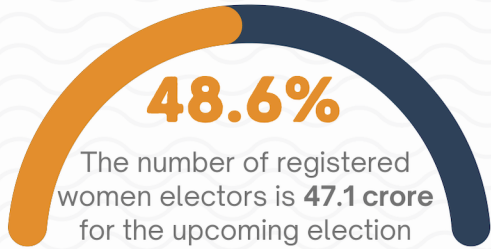




# WOMEN ELECTORS

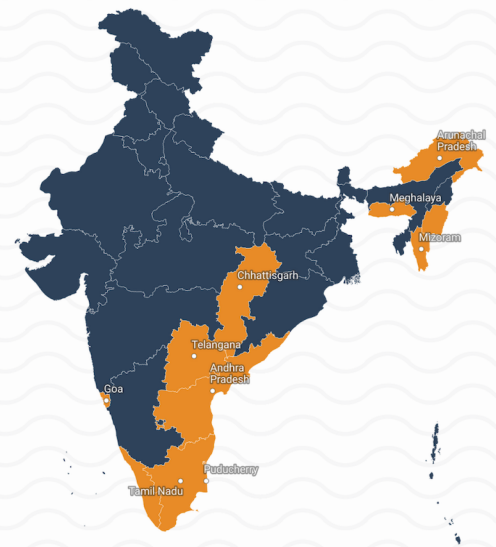

Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, and Bihar added the most number of new women electors since 2019

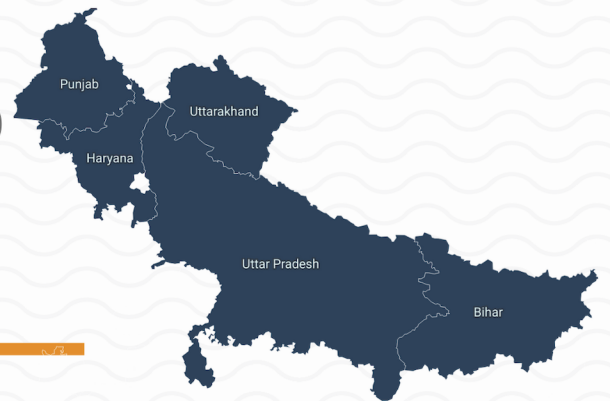

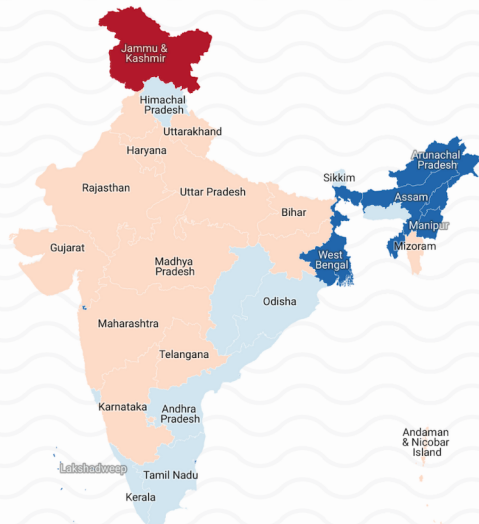
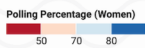
Low representation of women among **service electors (3.5%)** and **overseas electors (11%)**

In 2019, the polling percentage of women was **67.2%**, marginally lower than the national average of 67.4%. North Eastern States have the highest polling percentage (2019) among women voters. Jammu & Kashmir is the only state with less than 50% polling among women; 9 states with more than 80% polling.
